### Prerequisites for entering the major

**Class of 2023:** may register for the major upon completion of 6 of the 8 introductory requirements by submitting their academic record to the EP&E registrar  
**Class of 2024 and subsequent classes:** may register for the major upon completion of the 8 introductory requirements by the beginning of their 5th term of enrollment

**1 course from each of 8 categories:**

- (1) Ethics (PHIL 175 or DS\*)
- (2) Other Perspectives (from ANTH, ER&M, HIST, SOCY, WGSS, or DS\*)
- (3) Political Philosophy (PHIL 178, 114, 118, 108, or DS\*)
- \*2 terms of DS fulfills introductory requirements (1) thru (3)
- (4) Intro Political Science course (1 of PLSC 111, 116, or 113)
- (5) Intro Microeconomics (1 of ECON 108, 110, or 115)
- (6) Intro Macroeconomics (ECON 111 or 116)
- (7) Econometrics (1 of ECON 117, 123, 135, GLBL 121, S&DS 230 or 238)
- (8) Game Theory (1 of EP&E 220, 231, 295, 297, or ECON 159)

### Requirements for each degree

**15 term courses**  
(incl intro reqs & senior req)

ECON 121 or ECON 125

3 core courses in 2 out of 3 core areas (1 to include EP&E 215, 216, or 217)  
2 additional core courses, one must be 1 adv seminar

3 courses in area of concentration  
(includes senior req course)

### Senior Requirements

**Senior Essay in area of concentration**  
(Advanced seminar; EP&E 491; or EP&E 492 and 493)
